Dec 7 Prayer Watch For the Peaceful Transition to the New Administration

The election may be over, but the battle is still waging in, and against, our nation. We need to stand in the gap in intercession crying out to the Lord for the peaceful transition to the new Administration. Please consider the following prayer points as you intercede for our nation.

- That Americans will meet anger with civility there is potential for the enemy to stir anger in these final moments before the election and the antidote to this is civility and love (Prov 15:18)
- That Americans will face oppression with praise there may be a strong sense of depression (really it's oppression) and this can be fought with thanksgiving and praise (Ps 100:4)
- That believers push through complacency with courage there is the possibility that hopelessness could set in resulting in complacency and this can be fought with godly courage (Deut 31:6)
- That God would release the Spirit of the Fear of the Lord over our nation causing more people to depart from doing evil. (Job 28:28)
- Declare a release of God's assigned angels to now set everything in God's peaceful order for the election certification process. (1Cor 14:40)
- Declare that the counting of votes for the remaining house seats is now finalized with only valid ballots being counted.
- Declare that every state officially finalizes their election counts with honesty and integrity with no shenanigans or corruption of any kind. (Col 3:23-24)
- Declare that certifications in every state now flow smoothly with no delay, no conflicts and no disruptions.
- Declare that each secretary of state readily certifies their state's election results by Dec 11
- Declare that the Dec 17 date for Electoral College members to meet in each state capital to cast their electoral votes for president and vice-present, will take place with no delay or disruption of any kind.
- Declare that the electoral ballots will be submitted and counted by Congress on Jan 6 with no delay or disruption.
- Declare that the testimony of what has been done at the Federal level to shift America toward righteousness and justice will now flow down to the county and state levels. (Amos 5:24)
- Declare peace to America....that there will be no red flag events nationally or internationally to delay or derail the new administration. (Isa 32: 17-18)
- Declare confusion into the enemy's camp...that those with evil intentions cannot execute any plans to disrupt the election certification process. (Joshua 10:10)

- Declare that there will be no further weather disruptions to cause any delays regarding the transition to the new administration.
- Declare that there will be no threat of government shut down to delay or deny the Inauguration.
- Declare that there will be no threat of pandemic shutdown to delay or deny the Inauguration.
- Declare that the enemy has no plans that can have any effect on the election certification process.
- Declare that the earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof.... That the Word of God, Jesus Christ, rules and reigns over our nation. (Psa 24)
- Declare that every lie spoken about cabinet nominees are now exposed and make of no affect.
- Declare blessings over each member of the administration officials who are exiting on Jan 20.
- Declare that every nominee that is in Your will Lord God now be quickly and readily approved.
- Declare the uprooting of any and all demonic strongholds coming against the new administration.
- Ask that a male spiritual mentor come beside Pres Trump to guide him deeper understanding about is relationship with Jesus as Savior.
