Overview. Thank you for participating in a Church Prayer Watch or a County Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays! The vision of Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every field of harvest in our society to better align with God's will. We do this by calling churches and believers to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Source and Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each Field of Harvest are drafted by our Field of Harvest Prayer Team Leaders. As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. The prayer points in this digest were revealed to each prayer leader during the monthly prayer time with their team. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

A prayer for you: Lord God, help me to not conform to the pattern of this world, but let me now be transformed by the renewing of my mind. Let me be able to test and approve what Your will is—Your good, pleasing and perfect will.

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song or declare the attributes of God. I praise You Lord God. *You are Jehovah. You are infinite. You are omnipotent. You are good. You are love. You provide. You are peace. You are immutable. You are transcendent. You are just. You are holy. You are our healer. You are omnipresent. You are merciful. You are sovereign. You are our banner. You are wise. You are faithful. You are full of grace. You are our comforter. You are the Almighty. You are Father. You are the head of the Church. You are our intercessor. You are Master/Lord. You are our strength.*

3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses out loud then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to repent for, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed and repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member. Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family. Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank You Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God. –Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity. – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways. – Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Cultivate deeper love for one another. (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9)
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Instill deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil. (Ps 91:11)
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest to guide your prayers for the nine fields of harvest for Colorado. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

Core Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as The Church of Colorado now meets the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted or suffering from mental illness.
11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
13. We declare that the hearts of the people of the Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

1. We thank You, Lord, for mobilizing 60+ Church Prayer Watches which now cover every day of the year in non-stop, day and night prayer at the state level! Let every participating church faithfully complete their monthly Church Prayer Watch.
2. We pray for more young people to engage in one or more of the prayer initiatives or become a social media Prayer Influencer with Colorado Prays.
3. We ask for blessing and favor for people in engage in prayer through our social media marketing campaign called " Pray 64 in 24" Bless Josef as he guides the Board and Angie as she directs the initiative statewide.
4. We thank You Lord for our recent partnership with Truth & Liberty which has given us an influx of believers interested in mobilizing and connecting in prayer in their communities.
5. 12. We pray for favor to engage an army of believers in the monthly County Prayer Watch for each of the 64 Colorado counties. We ask, Lord, that every county have a fully subscribed 24hr Prayer Watch which will cover the state in non-stop, day and night prayer. 13. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor participating in the Church Prayer Watch (including myself).

Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. They are written each month by the leaders of the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams. You can join any of these teams from our website at <https://www.coprays.org/prayermeetings>. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Declare God's Word: Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions, declarations and decrees below in faith believing that we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1 John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)

Colorado Prays for the MARKETPLACE:

1. As it is written in Phil 4: 6-7, we exhort marketplace people across Colorado, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
2. As it is written in Isa 26:3, we declare to every person affected by the Colorado marketplace that God will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast because they trust in Him. Keep your focus on Him and trust Him fully regardless of circumstances and you can be at peace.
3. We declare that marketplace people across Colorado will make peace with their enemies if the Lord takes pleasure in their ways. Prov 16:7
4. We decree as it is written in Col 3:15 to people across Colorado, "Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts since, as members of one body, you were called to peace."
5. We decree to people across the Colorado marketplace as it is written in Psa 34:14, "Turn from evil and do good, seek peace and pursue it."

Colorado Prays for the CHURCH:

1. We decree to the Church of Colorado as it is written in Joshua 3:5 "Sanctify^l yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." Let every pastor encourage the congregation to consecrate themselves to prepare their hearts for the arrival of our soon coming King.
2. We pray for endurance for the Colorado church to keep their hearts pure and aware of the coming of her Bridegroom, Jesus.
3. We pray that the church now has deep spiritual discernment in this season of our state and nation. Give them eyes and ears trained by the Spirit instead of the flesh.
4. We pray that Colorado shepherds now become fearless leaders and bold protectors, keeping their sheep from succumbing to fear or going down the wrong paths.

Colorado Prays for ELECTIONS:

1. We decree that the false stories, testimonies and accusations put forth by ungodly people regarding our elections are no longer allowed in Colorado as divine order is now being restored in every level of Colorado government.
2. We decree that the Ecclesia of Colorado now celebrates and stands in agreement with our Almighty God regarding His will for Colorado, in His timing, as what is just and true and right for our state: that You Lord God now release all that You desire for the people and land of Colorado.
3. We decree that the people of Colorado now receive the peace of Jesus and the joy of the Lord so that they no longer submit to fear, anxiety or stress regarding their lives or the details of this election season.
4. We ask, Lord, for an influx of the Fear of the Lord over the people of Colorado regarding the election processes and our government.
5. We pray for a massive turnout of conservative voters this election and every election going forward...no more will the silent majority be silent.

Colorado Prays for LIFE:

1. We pray that our Sovereign Lord Jesus Christ stands in intercession for, and has mercy on, the people of Colorado who have allowed abortion to flourish in this state. We ask that they now come to the saving knowledge of Jesus which awakens them to the truth of the destructive evil of abortion which takes a human life.
2. We pray for a massive movement of remorse and repentance for allowing abortion in Colorado. Let it lead to an influx of God's glory which turns hearts to the children in the womb.
3. We pray for godly leadership to be put in place at all levels of Colorado government, education, healthcare, media and entertainment which begins to transition mindsets to support life for babies, adults and seniors rather than abortion, assisted suicide and euthanasia.
4. We ask, Lord, for a reconstruction of a Colorado culture of life, family and faith.
5. We pray for an increase in people across Colorado who actively advocate for an end to abortion and support for life in every pregnancy.
6. We ask, Lord, for creative ways for the prolife community to grow and collaborate to encourage high quality, life-affirming prenatal care for women in crisis.

Colorado Prays for the MEDIA:

1. We decree as it is written in Col 2:15 regarding media throughout Colorado: "He disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by his victory over them on the cross." Thank You, Jesus for victory over every form of media in Colorado.
2. Father God, we pray that people in all forms of media across Colorado are now truth bearers and contributors to unity. We pray that they now build up, rather than tear down.
3. In the powerful name of Jesus, we declare that the Lord rebuke the enemy for his ungodly effect on people within the media, that principalities and ungodly spirits are now torn out of every form of media.
4. We ask, Lord, for a continual hedge of protection around those who love You and work in Colorado media.
5. Give godly media people across Colorado Your provision, health and wisdom that Your truth now makes way across our state.
6. We pray that Holy Spirit now reveals himself to ungodly producers, station owners, anchors and reporters in ways that will cause them to turn to Jesus as their Savior.
7. We pray that the influence of the godly in Colorado media now outweighs that of the wicked.
8. We pray that those with evil plans in the media industry now be found out and replaced as their plans are shattered and fall apart under the power of the cross.
9. We declare that G. Soros will not be able to overtake 200+ U.S. radio stations as recently approved by the FCC.
10. We pray that social media Prayer Influencers with Colorado Prays now flow in blessings and abundance as they raise up more people to be influencers and tell the Good New to all who will listen and see.

Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

1. We declare Jesus Christ is King over the education system in Colorado.
2. Thank You, Jesus, for your blood which you already applied to our students, teachers, staff and administrators. May it be applied again with increase.
3. Thank You, Lord, for the increase of Christian schools opening and for parents that are teaching their kids in the way they ought to go, pointing toward you. We ask that You continue to increase those numbers.
4. Lord, we ask that You continue to change the hearts of more parents to raise up their children in the way they should go and You would give them the courage to be obedient to Your will for their children. (Proverbs 22:6, Deut. 6:4-9 and Psalm 78:5-8)
5. We ask You to till the soil and ready hearts for the transformation of lives as they receive the Gospel. We welcome and ask for Your revival and spiritual awakening across all Colorado schools to ignite and spread.
6. Jehovah Nissi, we cry out for Your protection over the students of Colorado, in health, in safety, in spirituality, in truth, in goodness and in beauty.

Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

1. Heavenly Father, we pray for a breakthrough to find, rescue, and bring home every remaining hostage, and for healing in body, soul and spirit for all the people living Israel.
2. We pray for supernatural godly wisdom, counsel, strategies, plans and endurance for the government and military leaders in Israel. May they be in one accord as they fight this war.
3. We declare a new level of safety for every IDF soldier, that You would watch over and keep them safe in every operation they carry out, and let them know that You are with them.
4. We thank You, Lord, that the second barrage of missiles from Iran did so little damage and that the U.S. is helping Israel to defend against future attacks.
5. We pray for humanitarian aid to pour into Israel from the nations as they deal with the cost of war, the needs of displaced people, families of soldiers who are unable to work, the economy put on hold, the cost of caring for the sick and wounded, etc. Let us be their helping hands!
6. We pray for the Messianic believers in Israel as they serve with their fellow Jews in the IDF and go through the same trials and tribulations, that they would come to be seen as one with their brothers and sisters, and that the hope which lies within them would shine forth as a beacon of truth and light and love!
7. We pray for all Christians in Israel for Your favor, that they would work together in unity as they minister to all the people of Israel
8. We pray that You would strengthen and encourage all Israelis and let them not lose courage or confidence in their country.
9. We pray for an outpouring of Holy Spirit across the whole Middle East, to bring those lost in darkness into the inheritance of the saints who are in light, and into the Kingdom of Your beloved Son (Col 1:12-13).

Colorado Prays for the FAMILY:

1. We pray that the families of Colorado would now stand with Israel and be moved to pray for them.
2. We pray for forgiveness that the families of Colorado have given the enemy a foothold. We ask, Lord, that You now close that foothold in every Colorado family.
3. We thank You, Lord, that men and women now rise up as Godly leaders in Colorado homes.
4. In the mighty name of Jesus, we stand in the gap for the children of Colorado, declaring that the enemy will not have them.
5. We pray for nursing and pregnant mothers in Colorado, that they will have strength and courage to raise their children in the knowledge of Jesus as their Lord with biblical values guiding the way they should go.

Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

1. In the mighty name of Jesus, we declare that the connections between unrighteous powers and principalities and our state government are now severed and made of no affect, especially ties to Mammon, Leviathan, and Baal worship.
2. We declare that our state officials are now bound to holiness and right standing with the Lord God Almighty causing them to accept God's plan for their position and realm of influence. However, if they reject God's plan, we declare they will be quickly removed from their position, power and control over the people and land of Colorado.
3. We declare that, when the righteous rule our Colorado government, the people rejoice. Prov 29:2 NLT
4. We declare that our God's candidates and issues will prevail in the November elections.
5. We declare protection over Colorado laws, our constitution and all right standing government officials as we go through this critical election.
6. We declare that corruption in Colorado government will not prevail but will be exposed and those involved held accountable.

Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

1. In these tumultuous times, we thank You, Lord God, for the Colorado men and women serving as First Responders: dispatchers, police officers, firefighters, EMT - especially for those volunteers aiding the victims of the disasters in the southeast United States.
2. Prompt each Colorado First Responder to start each shift by dedicating the work shift, and themselves, to You.
3. We ask, Lord, that You cover each Colorado First Responder with the blood of Jesus so that they will be protected from all the spiritual attacks of the enemy.
4. We ask, Lord, that You now release Your angels to be with every Colorado First Responder to guide and empower them as they serve You by serving others.
5. We pray that each believing First Responder sees every person they serve as a child of God who is having issues in their life. Let God's compassion and firm love flow through every Colorado First Responder.
6. At the end of each shift, prompt them to leave all the negative contacts, thoughts, feelings and concerns in Your capable hands so as to not internalize them or take them home to their families.
7. Help them to go off duty rejoicing in the power of Holy Spirit while thanking You for all You did to and through them during their shift.
8. Surround their family members with Your Holy Angels to bless and protect them at all times. Cover them with the blood of Jesus which protects them from any spiritual attacks from the enemy.
9. Let each family member confidently know that God is always with their First Responder to keep the whole family safe with Your comforting love, joy and peace.

Colorado Prays for the ARTS:

1. We praise You, Lord, and thank You for Your creative gifts that You so freely give to both believers and pre-believers in Colorado. We pray, Lord, for an outpouring of Holy Spirit into artists across Colorado. Acts 2:17
2. Many artists consider themselves spiritual but do not follow Holy Spirit. In the name and power of Jesus, we now break off every false spirit from Colorado Creatives. We pray that the veil of deception now be lifted from their eyes and hearts so that they now see God's Truth. John 9:25
3. We pray that every Colorado artist be completely healed as they see and accept God as the Healer and as described in the Greek word "sozo", meaning saved, healed and delivered. We ask that artists be healed in their body and mind from all sickness, disease and trauma. Luke 6:17-18
4. We pray for the covering of the blood of Jesus over each Colorado artist and their artwork. Let the Glory of God shine through them. Ephesians 2:12-14

Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

1. We praise You, Lord, that You have a just heart to rule and regulate the energy sector across Colorado.
2. We ask, Lord, that You guide the hearts and minds of governmental leaders to follow Your way of ruling regarding Colorado energy.
3. We pray that every business leader in the energy sector now wisely stewards the blessed treasures contained in the land of Colorado as a beacon to the nation of God's goodness.
4. We ask, Lord, that you give wisdom to Colorado leaders that will be heard and followed so that the energy of Colorado and this nation is in lock step with Your will.
5. We ask, Lord, that You stop legislation that opposes Your will and the leaders who make plans to go against Your will and what You call good in our land.
6. We ask, Lord, that You manifest Your glory in every Colorado energy operation, causing lives to be blessed, souls to be saved and Your Name to be exalted.
