Overview. Thank you for participating in a Church Prayer Watch or a County Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays! The vision of Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every field of harvest in our society to better align with God's will. We do this by calling churches and believers to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). When the Church Prayer Watch and County Prayer Watches are fully subscribed, Colorado will be covered 3 times in non-stop, day and night prayer!

Source and Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each Field of Harvest are drafted by our Field of Harvest Prayer Team Leaders. As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. The prayer points in this digest were revealed to each prayer leader during the monthly prayer time with their team. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

A prayer for you: Lord God, help me to not conform to the pattern of this world, but let me now be transformed by the renewing of my mind. Let me be able to test and approve what Your will is—Your good, pleasing and perfect will.

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song or declare the attributes of God. I praise You Lord God. *You are Jehovah. You are infinite. You are omnipotent. You are good. You are love. You provide. You are peace. You are immutable. You are transcendent. You are just. You are holy. You are our healer. You are omnipresent. You are merciful. You are sovereign. You are our banner. You are wise. You are faithful. You are full of grace. You are our comforter. You are the Almighty. You are Father. You are the head of the Church. You are our intercessor. You are Master/Lord. You are our strength.*

3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses out loud then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to repent for, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed and repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member. Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family. Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank You Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God. –Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity. – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways. – Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Cultivate deeper love for one another. (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9)
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Instill deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil. (Ps 91:11)
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest to guide your prayers for the nine fields of harvest for Colorado. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

Core Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as The Church of Colorado now meets the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted or suffering from mental illness.
11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
13. We declare that the hearts of the people of the Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

Colorado Prays: Ministry Prayer Points:

1. We thank You, Lord, for mobilizing 60+ Church Prayer Watches which now cover every day of the year in non-stop, day and night prayer at the state level! Let every participating church faithfully complete their monthly Church Prayer Watch. We ask Lord for more churches to engage to cover each county in non-stop prayer.
2. We pray for more young people to engage in one or more of the prayer initiatives or become a social media Prayer Influencer with Colorado Prays.
3. We ask for blessing and favor for someone to join our leadership team to lead our social media campaigns.
4. We ask Lord for new partnerships, strategies and resources to spread the word to Colorado pastors and intercessors about the Church Prayer Watch Initiative, the County Prayer Watch initiative, the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams and the Civic Prayer Teams. Give our leadership eyes to see the doors You are opening for those partnerships.
5. We ask for protection and wisdom for every Colorado Prays Board member including Amy, Brad, Phil, Brittany, Mark, Kristen and Mike. Bless Brittany as she now balances motherhood and work.
6. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Team leaders who are laser-focused on each of the fields of harvest covered in this Prayer Digest and for their physical and spiritual protection. We pray blessings on our Leaders including John, Lisa, Amy, Mathew, MaryAnn, Joshua, Kaity, Nic, Gaylyn, Laura, Catherine, Wendi, George, Angie, Laccricia, and Justin.
7. We thank You, Lord, for bringing us Kingdom Helpers (Ceasar and Raica) as our admin support. Bless them, Lord, with an abundance of new clients and great prosperity as they help advance the Kingdom of God in the Philippines and here in America.
8. We thank You, Lord, for bringing more passionate Advocates to our team who will help spread the word about the prayer initiatives of Colorado Prays. 11. We pray for favor to engage an army of believers in the monthly County Prayer Watch for each of the 64 Colorado counties. We ask, Lord, that every county have a fully subscribed 24hr Prayer Watch which will cover the state in non-stop, day and night prayer. Prompt believers to engage in the County Prayer Watch by making a promise to pray for an hour or more one day a month in their county's monthly Prayer Watch. <https://www.coprays.org/county-prayer-watch>.
12. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor participating in the Church Prayer Watch (including myself).

Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. They are written each month by the leaders of the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams. You can join any of these teams from our website at <https://www.coprays.org/prayermeetings>. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Declare God's Word: Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions, declarations and decrees below in faith believing that we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1 John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)

Colorado Prays for the MARKETPLACE:

1. As it is written in Matt 11:28, we exhort marketplace people across Colorado, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."
2. As it is written in Psa 61:1, we declare to every person affected by the Colorado marketplace "Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvation comes from him."
3. We decree as it is written in Exodus 33:14 (NIV) to marketplace people statewide "The Lord replied, 'My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.'"
4. We declare that every person in the Colorado marketplace now chooses to submit to Psalm 23:2 (ESV) "He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters."
5. We declare peace to workers, managers and business owners across Colorado as it is written in Isaiah 26:3 (NIV) "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."

Colorado Prays for ELECTIONS:

1. We praise You Lord and thank you for a soon coming shift toward godly principles in our legislative bodies.
2. We thank You Jesus for the heavenly battle that is taking place to restore the integrity of the Colorado election process and ballot counting...especially for any remaining positions that have not been declared.
3. We declare as it is written in Psalm 6:10 that the enemies of our elections process will now be overwhelmed with shame and anguish that they turn back and suddenly be put to shame.
4. We declare that there will be no monkey business to impede the inauguration in any way.
5. We declare that elected officials and the masses are now steered toward their right minds as the veil of deception is now lifted off of Colorado.
6. We declare that the Colorado Ecclesia will no longer accept anything that is not true, righteous and just regarding the elections processes across Colorado.
7. We declare a shift statewide towards biblical truth and righteousness in every piece of legislation and in every political office.

Colorado Prays for the CHURCH:

1. As it written in Isaiah 11: 2-5, we declare Heavenly Father that the manifestations of your Spirit now rest upon Your Bride across Colorado (THE CHURCH).
2. We declare a release of the Spirit of Wisdom upon every Colorado church leader and believer so that we prayerfully navigate this current season in the natural and spiritual world according to Your biblical narrative and commands.
3. We ask Lord that Your Bride across Colorado now flows with the Spirit of Understanding, so each believer more fully comprehends who You are and how Your Spirit is moving in our current situations.
4. We declare that Colorado believers now receive the Spirit of Counsel from Holy Spirit and from the Word of God regarding our daily assignments for our God's Kingdom.
5. We declare that the Bride across Colorado now stands strong with the Spirit of Might to accomplish all that God has assigned for them.
6. We declare that believers statewide now welcome the Fear of the Lord so they may abide in positional alignment with the Sovereign God of the universe.
7. We declare that THE CHURCH of Colorado now walks in the Spirit of Righteousness with the confidence, humility and authority of Jesus Christ.
8. We declare a release of greater faithfulness amongst Colorado believers to keep pursuing God with our whole hearts and enduring our calling as good soldiers of God's Kingdom.
9. We declare oh God that the Church across Colorado would now rise up in these characteristics of the Holy Spirit. That every believer would know God intimately through every one of His manifestations of these characteristics.

Colorado Prays for LIFE:

1. We pray for continued unity and collaboration within Colorado's Pro-life community. That the enemy will not use the Amendment 79 loss to discourage or cause complacency. Let God arise and His enemies be scattered.
2. We pray for a greater focus on life-affirming care. That more physicians will take a courageous stand to model their practices in a way that is life promoting and stands for Truth. And that God will protect their right to conscientious objection.
3. We pray for legislators to work with the pro-life medical community to draft legislation that will improve access to pregnancy care for all women.
4. We declare that the pro-life medical community will continue to write and speak to their communities not only to educate about abortion, but also to glorify the Lord, praising the beauty, complexity and all the wonders of life in the womb because God's people celebrate the dignity, purpose, value, design and dignity of every human being.
5. We pray that Pregnancy Resource centers will get the support and resources they need for 2025 and that more will move into a medical model of wholistic prenatal care, supporting moms and helping to overcome barriers in pregnancy care.

Colorado Prays for the ARTS:

1. We thank You Jesus for releasing greater, godly, creativity in all categories of the arts across Colorado.
2. We declare that those in Colorado arts now bring praise to God as it is written Psalm 150 "Praise the Lord! Praise God in His sanctuary; praise Him in the heavens of His power! Praise Him for His mighty acts; praise Him according to the abundance of His greatness! Praise Him with trumpet sound; praise Him with lute and harp! Praise Him with tambourine and dance; praise Him with stringed wind instruments or flutes! Praise Him with resounding cymbals; praise Him with loud clashing cymbals! Let everything that has breath, and every breath of life, now praise the Lord!
3. We thank You Holy Spirit for Your presence in artist studios, art galleries, and arts organizations across Colorado.
4. We declare that artists are now guided by the Spirit of Wisdom and understanding in every form of art.
5. We ask Holy Spirit that You now pour into every Colorado artist giving them deep revelation of Your love which is revealed through their art.
6. Lord we bless Your plan over the arts organizations across Colorado. Let each one engage believing artists who have Godly influence over other artists in the organization.
7. We ask You Lord to position Your beloved Kingdom artists in the areas where they can be salt and light. Raise up Jesus-loving art teachers and art leaders throughout the state, so they may disciple artists in Spirit-filled art that prophesies and testifies Your Love.
8. As it is written in Eph 2: 12-14, we decree a release of the redemptive, uniting blood of Jesus over every Colorado artist and their artwork.

Colorado Prays for the FAMILY:

1. We welcome President Trump and the new administration. Let each member of the administration be blessed and protected by the Blood of the Lamb.
2. We ask Lord that You remind each one to uphold their mandate to protect American families.
3. We thank you Lord for Your sovereignty over our leadership and pray that we will see many changes that positively impact families in Colorado and nationwide.
4. We pray for the people of Colorado and repent that the majority chose to uphold and expand abortion to take the lives of more innocent unborn babies.
5. We repent that the apparent majority have voted to reject the covenant of marriage between one man and one woman.
6. We ask Lord that THE CHURCH across Colorado now arise to take a strong stand for Kingdom values going forward.
7. We declare Your Kingdom come, Your Will be done Lord God regarding Colorado families in 2025 and beyond.

Colorado Prays for the MEDIA:

1. We declare blessings and protection for every Colorado believer in any aspect of journalism and media.
2. We declare a revival awakening in the hearts and minds of pre-believers who work in, or with, any form of journalistic media in Colorado.
3. We ask Lord that you let Your glory now fall on every aspect of Colorado media to overtake every form of journalism with Your Truth so that honest, unbiased journalism is produced from our state.
4. Lord, we ask that You bring a shift from the existing mass media empires to grass roots platforms that present factual truth and have a bigger influence in the minds of people across Colorado and the nation.
5. We thank You Lord, as it is written in John 4:1, that the Good News of the gospel can now reach thousands in an instant through media, causing them to quickly accept Jesus as their Savior.

Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

1. We declare that Jesus Christ is King over the education system at all levels across Colorado.
2. Thank You, Jesus, for cleansing the curriculum of our schools to remove teachings that dishonor any segment of society.
3. Thank You, Lord, for the increase of Christian schools opening and for parents who are teaching their children in the way they ought to go, pointing toward you. We ask that You continue to increase those numbers.
4. We declare blessings on ministries that encourage children to read their bibles and engage in prayer for one another during and after school hours.
5. We ask You to till the soil and ready hearts for the transformation of lives as they receive the Gospel.
6. We welcome and ask for a mighty revival and spiritual awakening in every Colorado school.
7. Lord God, we cry out for Your protection over the students of Colorado, in health, in safety, in spirituality, in truth, in goodness and in beauty.

Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

1. We repent, Lord God, on behalf of the state of Colorado for passing laws and amendments to our state constitution that are in direct opposition to Your truth and Your Will.
2. We declare that the Word of the Lord is true, and the people of Colorado celebrate when the righteous rule across our state.
3. We declare that the 'hidden' things in all levels of our government shall be brought to the light and accountability will prevail.
4. Thank You Jesus for your faithfulness to our state and nation and for your grace and mercy. We now choose to trust You and walk with You no matter what we see or hear.
5. We declare the state of Colorado stands with, and blesses Israel, therefore, Colorado shall be blessed.

Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

1. Heavenly Father, we pray for a breakthrough to find, rescue, and bring home every remaining hostage, and for healing in body, soul and spirit for all Israel.
2. We pray for supernatural Godly wisdom, counsel, strategies, plans and endurance for the government and military leaders in Israel. May they be in one accord as they fight this war, bring an end to Hamas influence and establish safety from all enemies on every front.
3. We pray that Israel would find greater favor with the free nations of the world, would be appreciated for standing against intolerance and terrorism, and that the anti-Semitism in the UN would be called out for what it is.
4. We pray for a strong and positive relationship for Israel with the new U.S. government administration.
5. We pray that the Church would have a greater understanding of the irrevocable calling of Israel in God's great plan of redemption as written in Rom 11:29 and of His eternal covenant with the children of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob as Paul said in Rom 11:1, "Has God cast away His people? Certainly not!"
6. We pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May those who love you be secure. May there be peace within your walls and security within your citadels."
7. May the Spirit of God speak to the hearts of Jewish people in Israel and worldwide to know the truth of His Being, and to know their Messiah.
8. As it is written in Col 1: 12-13, we pray for an outpouring of Your Holy Spirit across the whole Middle East, to bring those lost in darkness into the inheritance of the saints in light, and into the Kingdom of Your beloved Son.

Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

1. We ask Lord, that Colorado First Responders be able to have time to enjoy Christmas with their family and friends. Bless their relationships with all their family members and bless their time together celebrating the Birth of Your Son.
2. Let every First Responder in our state experience the true meaning of Christmas, the gift of your son Jesus.
3. As Colorado First Responders prepare to start their shift, prompt each one to put on the full armor of God to be protected from any assaults of the enemy. Let them go forth in the power of your Holy Spirit.
4. We pray that each believing First Responder now sees every person they serve as a child of God who is having issues in their life. Let God's compassion and firm love flow through every Colorado First Responder.
5. We ask, Lord, that You now release Your angels to be with every Colorado First Responder to guide and empower them as they serve You by serving others.
6. Let each First Responder go off duty rejoicing in the power of Holy Spirit in their lives while thanking You for all You did for them and through them during their shift.
7. We ask Lord, that You allow each person to leave all their negative experiences, contacts, thoughts, feelings and concerns in Your capable hands at the end of their shift so as to not internalize them or take them home to their families.

Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

1. We love you Lord and thank You that, even now, You are putting the people in place who are needed to guide the energy industry for Colorado and the nation in this next season.
2. Father, we thank You that You have called each one of us to, be a light in your Kingdom. Let every believer in the Colorado energy sector now rise up as a Light to God's Kingdom.
3. We ask Lord, that doors that were once shut against the Colorado energy industry would now be opened wide to meet every energy need in this nation and beyond. Let chains of restraint now fall off energy businesses statewide.
4. We ask for Your wisdom Lord God to manage the resources and run the energy industry that You have blessed us with in Colorado.
5. We call forth God-fearing, Holy Spirit filled leaders into every Colorado energy business and into the legislative bodies governing the industry for our state. Awaken those who need to know Jesus as their Savior.
6. We declare a release of innovations that make energy production and distribution more efficient and effective while lowering costs for end users.
7. Let the energy sector produce life-saving spiritual energy through believers who acknowledge you at work every day even as they help produce a greater level of needed oil and gas energy for our state and nation.
8. We stand in faith believing that the energy industry will be restored as a strong component of the Colorado economy.
9. We wait with expectant hope as Holy Spirit hovers over the Colorado energy sector bringing hope to those in need of employment allowing them to fulfill the plans He has for their lives.
